

MOPAC End-User Software License Agreement (Commercial)

Important:

This License Agreement (“Agreement”) is a legal agreement between you, the end user (either an individual or an entity), and Stewart Computational Chemistry (“SCC”). By checking the “Agree” box below, you signify that you have read the SCC License Agreement and accept its terms. If you do not agree to the Agreement’s terms, please delete all copies of this Software.

Grant of License.

SCC grants, and you hereby accept, a non-exclusive license to install and use one copy of the enclosed software product (“Software”) in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. This licensed copy of the Software may only be used on a single computer. **You may not:** (a) electronically transfer the Software from one computer to another, (b) distribute copies of the Software to others, or (c) modify or translate the Software without the prior written consent of SCC. The Software may be placed on a file or disk server connected to a network, provided that a license has been purchased or legally acquired and registered for every computer with access to that server or some license management software is present and in use to allow only licensed users to access the Software. You may make only those copies of the Software which are necessary to install and use it as permitted by this Agreement, or are for purposes of backup and archival records; all copies shall bear SCC’s copyright and proprietary notices. You may not make copies of any accompanying materials without prior, written notice from SCC.

Ownership.

The Software is and at all times shall remain the sole property of SCC or its Licensors. This ownership is protected by the copyright laws of the United States and by international treaty provisions. Upon expiration or termination of this Agreement, you shall promptly delete all copies of the Software and accompanying materials. You may not modify, decompile, reverse engineer, or disassemble the Software.

Assignment Restrictions.

You shall not rent, lease, or otherwise sublet the Software or any part thereof. You may transfer on a permanent basis the rights granted under this license provided you transfer this Agreement and all copies of the Software, including prior versions, and all accompanying materials (included in the product download). The recipient must agree to the terms of this Agreement in full and register this transfer with SCC.

SCC Limited Warranty.

SCC’s sole warranty with respect to the Software is that it shall be free of errors in program logic or documentation attributable to SCC and of errors that prevent the performance of the principal computing functions of the Software. SCC warrants this for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of receipt of the Software.

SCC’s Liability.

In no event shall SCC or its agents be liable for any indirect, special, or consequential damages, such as, but not limited to, loss of anticipated profits or other economic loss in connection with or arising out of the use of the software by you or the services provided for in this Agreement, even if SCC has been advised of the possibility of such damages. SCC’s entire liability and your exclusive remedy shall be, at SCC’s discretion, to return the Software and proof of purchase to SCC for either (a) return of any license fee, or (b) correction or replacement of Software that does not meet the terms of this limited warranty.

No Other Warranties.

SCC and its agents disclaim other implied warranties, including, but not limited to, implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for any purpose, and implied warranties arising by usage of trade, course of dealing, or course of performance.
